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DESIGN INCLUSIONS:

Provide Professional Mechanical Engineering and Drafting services to assist Mayers to determine the most cost-effective approach to replace the existing HVAC systems with the goal to help bring the existing mechanical, plumbing, and Medgas systems in the hospital up to code (including the 2030 upgrade requirements).

- Meet with the customer on site to discuss the long-term goals of the facility, obtain a list of areas with climate control problems, and potential phasing to minimize the impacts to the daily operations
- Provide field work on site (same trip as above meeting) to gather as-built conditions and equipment info (although the study will be primarily about HVAC, the as-built plumbing and medgas systems will be reviewed to determine the impacts associated with the HVAC). Note that it is assumed that maintenance staff will provide/set up ladders and/or dust containment systems to view the equipment, ducting, and piping systems.
- Review as-built documentation and previously provided studies
- Obtain equipment cutsheets as necessary
- Perform preliminary HVAC load calculations and equipment sizing
- Work with Architect (contracted separately) to determine a rough scope and phasing plan
- Provide schematic design work to convey recommendations and to allow estimates to be prepared
- Perform 2D CAD drafting
- Submit a report of findings electronically with recommendations and estimated costs

Provide additional Professional Mechanical Engineering services to prepare, present, and discuss the report findings with the customer on site.
